ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER: 2007-05

49th CIRCUIT COURT HOLIDAYS

It appearing to the court that it is necessary and essential that this Administrative Order be issued for the purpose of regulating the practice of internal management.

Pursuant to MCR 8.110(D)(2), and MCR 8.112(B), and as modified for the local practices applicable in the respective counties, the 49th Circuit Court observes the following holidays:

Mecosta County:

New Year's Day, January 1st
Martin Luther King Day, the third Monday in January
President's Day, the third Monday in February
Good Friday, the Friday preceding Easter Sunday – close at noon
Memorial Day, the last Monday in May
Independence Day, July 4th
Labor Day, the first Monday in September
Veteran's Day, November 11th
Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November
Friday after Thanksgiving
Christmas Eve, December 24th
Christmas Day, December 25th

Osceola County:

New Year's Day, January 1st
Martin Luther King Day, the third Monday in January
President's Day, the third Monday in February
Good Friday, the Friday preceding Easter Sunday – close at noon
Memorial Day, the last Monday in May
Independence Day, July 4th
Labor Day, the first Monday in September
Columbus Day, the second Monday in October
Veteran's Day, November 11th
Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November
Friday after Thanksgiving
Christmas Eve, December 24th

When New Year's Day, Independence Day, Veteran's Day or Christmas Day falls on Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be a holiday. When New Year's Day, Independence Day, Veteran's Day, or Christmas Day falls on Sunday, the following Monday shall be a holiday.

When Christmas Eve (Mecosta County) falls on Friday, the preceding Thursday shall be a holiday. When Christmas Eve or New Year's Eve (Osceola County) falls on Friday, the preceding Thursday shall be a holiday.

When Christmas Eve (Mecosta County) falls on Saturday or Sunday, the preceding Friday shall be a holiday. When Christmas Eve or New Year's Eve (Osceola County) falls on Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be a holiday. When Christmas Eve or New Year's Eve (Osceola County) falls on Sunday, the following Tuesday shall be a holiday.

The 49th Circuit Court hereby rescinds the previous Administrative Order 1985-4 regarding holidays.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until further order of this Court.
