

JUVENILE DELINQUENCY

The Family Division oversees all Juvenile Delinquency proceedings where a minor has been charged with criminal activity.

Standard Orders of Juvenile Probation:

- You shall not violate any law of the United States or the State of Michigan; not violate any county, city or municipal ordinance.
- You shall not leave the State of Michigan or the County of Mecosta without the permission of the Court and/or your parent(s), guardian, school officials, and other interested in your general welfare.
- You shall attend school every day and every schedule class and follow all rules and regulations of the school
- You shall promptly and fully obey all rules, regulations, and reasonable commands of your parent(s), guardian, school officials, probation officer and other interested in your general welfare.
- You shall keep this Court informed at all times of your address and telephone number and inform the Court of any changes thereof.
- Your whereabouts shall be known by your parent(s) at all times and you shall be home every night Sunday through Thursday by 8:00 p.m. Friday and Saturday nights by 10:00 p.m., and there remain unless you are in the company of your parent(s).
- You shall not use any alcoholic beverage and/or controlled substance.
- You shall not engage in any antisocial conduct.
- You shall not associate with any person on probation.
- You shall no leave the school grounds at any time.
- You shall observe all the rules of the school bus and driver.
- You shall have all homework and chores done every night before you may leave home for the evening.
- Further, if any reports of misconduct of willful violations of these orders comes to the attention of this Court, you will be brought back into Court.
- Said minor shall be eligible for In-Home Care Services
